On Sunday, March 25th from 12:30-4:00 pm, the Joint Cascade Brewers Cup and Puget Sound Pro-Am, along with the Washington Homebrewers Association, will be presenting awards celebrating homebrewing excellence at Redhook Brewery. The Cascade Brewers Guild, Boeing Employees Wine and Beer Makers Club, and Impaling Ales will be announcing winners in the 2012 Joint Cascade Brewers Cup and Puget Sound Pro-Am. This competition had 513 entries making it the largest Washington homebrewing competition ever.

The competition will also be featuring as many as 16 breweries selecting beers to be scaled up and brewed on their systems. These selections will also be announced during the ceremony.
